### ATTENTION STUDENTS!!

**WEB REGISTRATION** - All current students are required to register for their classes through PeopleSoft Registration. The website is [HTTP://WWW.DICKINSONSTATE.COM](http://www.dickinsonstate.com). Students may also check this website to see if they have holds on their accounts. Also, ALL students that have less than 60 credits completed are required to see their advisor prior to registration of classes.

**CLOSED CLASSES FORMS** - In order to register for a closed course students must go directly to the instructor and/or the Department Chair for permission. The Department Chair will deliver the approved closed class forms directly to the Office of Academic Records for registration.

**EXCESS LOAD FORMS** - If a student wishes to register for more than 18 credits they must go directly to their advisor and/or Department chair of their major for permission.

**APPLICATION FOR GRADUATION** - Students who wish to graduate in December 2008 **MUST** apply for graduation **BEFORE September 1, 2008**. It is also recommended that students intending to complete their degree in May 2009 should apply for graduation by January 1, 2009.

**ADMINISTRATIVE WITHDRAWAL FROM COURSE** - An academic affairs policy is being implemented in order to accommodate students who wish to enter a closed class when it becomes apparent that a currently registered student will not be utilizing his/her enrollment in that class. Therefore, be advised that, faculty members who are teaching sections of closed courses will be reporting all students who fail to attend at least one class session of those courses during the first week of instruction to the Office of Academic Records. At the discretion of the instructor, a student so reported may be administratively withdrawn from that particular course without prior notice. Consequently, it is extremely important that you personally notify your instructor(s) prior to the start of classes should you find it necessary to miss any class during the initial week each term.

## FINAL EXAMINATION SCHEDULE

#### DISTANCE EDUCATION CLASSES

##### IVN OR FACE-TO-FACE:

Instructors of distance education courses should choose either Option 1 or Option 2 with respect to the administration of final exams.

In determining which option to utilize, the instructor should select the option which will not conflict, overlap, or disrupt the regular final exam schedule listed below, which regular on-campus students must follow.

**OPTION 1 - Administer final exam during the last regularly scheduled class session prior to (on campus) final exam week.**

**OPTION 2 - Administer final exam during (on campus) final exam week on the same day and time as the regularly scheduled class session. (Contact Distance Coordinator at 483-2541 to set up room.)**

*NOTE: REGARDLESS OF THE OPTION SELECTED, STUDENTS SHOULD BE NOTIFIED OF THE DATE AND TIME OF THE FINAL EXAM AT THE BEGINNING OF THE SEMESTER.*
