Participation in the Sophomore Portfolio Review is required for all Art majors, minors & Graphic Design minors in their sophomore year. Sophomores seeking an art degree should have completed 2D design, Drawing I and either completed or be enrolled in 3D design, an Art History course and Drawing II. This includes Art & Design equivalent courses transferred from another institution. Failure to sign up for and complete the Sophomore Portfolio Review will result in a hold being placed on your enrollment.

Students may choose between Photo I Art 280 or Printmaking I Art 270. They must take one of those courses. They may also choose between Oil Painting Art 220 or Water Media I Art 225. They need 6 credits total from these courses.
