## Online Concentrations

Minot State University offers these **fully online** concentration options for Dickinson State University students completing graduate course work in Education:

- **Business** (30 total credits)
- **Curriculum and Instruction** (30 total credits)
- **Special Education** (35 total credits)

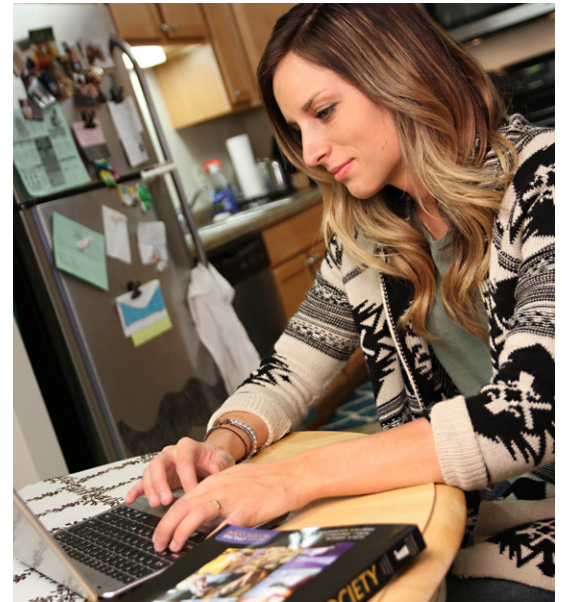

### Curriculum and Instruction Concentration

Minot State's MED Curriculum and Instruction Concentration has been developed specifically to benefit DSU students. The online concentration will consist of course work centered on curriculum development and pedagogical practice. By focusing on these broader dimensions of teacher education, this concentration will have the flexibility to include a variety of disciplines. Furthermore, this could provide foundational work for students seeking future educational leadership programs. The curriculum and instruction concentration includes in the following courses, all offered during the summer:

- Curriculum Theory (3 credits)
- Assessment (3 credits)
- Data Driven Instruction (3 credits)
- Educational Leadership (3 credits)

*Note: DSU's EDUC 501, 511, 521, 531, and 541 may be accepted to fulfill certain requirements from MSU's core.*
